Dear Kama'aina Kids Families and Friends,

In an additional effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the mayors for Oahu and Maui counties recently released a proclamation that makes it mandatory for all citizens to wear fabric face coverings or masks when not at home.

After receiving clarification from the Mayor's office we learned:

- Parents and family members must wear masks while dropping off and picking up children
- Staff must wear masks the entire time they are at the center
- Children 5 and under are not required to wear masks. It is unsafe to place masks on children under the age of 2.

Please note that we REQUIRE that all children or staff who have any signs of illness stay at home. Any child who exhibits a fever of over 100 degrees or other symptoms of illness will be sent home from school. Sick children will be isolated from other children while waiting to go home.

Of course, Kama'aina Kids is still using the very strictest cleaning standards and wearing masks will not replace our handwashing, sanitizing or disinfection efforts.

Our very highest priority is to care for your children in a safe and healthy environment.
